One cent municipal sales tax questions to be answered

November 21, 2008 – The Association of Manitoba Municipalities (AMM) 10th Annual Convention runs from Monday, November 24 to Thursday, November 27, 2008. Over 70 resolutions will be voted on by the delegate body, one of which is a late resolution calling for a one cent municipal sales tax to be allocated to municipalities for municipal infrastructure. This resolution is being sponsored by a number of municipalities, including the City of Portage la Prairie, the RM of Westbourne, the RM of Cameron, the City of Brandon, the RM of Alexander, and the City of Winnipeg.

The AMM, the City of Winnipeg and the City of Brandon have scheduled time during the Annual Convention to present comments and answer questions about the proposed resolution.
