## AMM to meet with Mayors, Reeves & CAOs

**March 2, 2007** – The Association of Manitoba Municipalities (AMM) will host its annual series of Mayors, Reeves and CAOs meetings between March 5 and 20, 2007. These meetings are held in each of the AMM's seven districts.
