PRESIDENT RON BELL

September 26, 2008 – AMM President Ron Bell announced today that he will not seek re-election for AMM President.

President Bell is in his fourth term as AMM President. He was first elected in 2004, after serving as Urban Vice-President for several years. Prior to that, he represented the Midwestern District as Urban Director. He has been Mayor of the Town of Birtle since 1995.

Bell made the decision to step down over a number of months. “It was not an easy decision, but one I am confident is the right one,” he explains. “I feel that I have accomplished many of the things I hoped to when first elected to serve as President, and am satisfied that I have done the job to the best of my ability. It is simply time to move on.”

Elections for AMM President, Vice-President Rural and Vice-President Urban will take place during the AMM 10th Annual Convention, being held from November 24-27, 2008 at the Winnipeg Convention Centre.

The term of office for these positions is one year. There is no limit to the number of years that a President or Vice-President can hold office.
