IMPORTANT NOTES

Expenditures

Expenditure figures for the RCMP represent only the amount billed to the municipality and not the total cost of the contract, nor any additional policing costs (accommodation, support staff, etc.) incurred by the municipality. Civilian employees provided by the municipality are not included.

Municipalities with populations under 15,000 are billed 70% of total expenditures.
Municipalities with populations over 15,000 are billed 90% of total expenditures.

Crime Data

An incident is a set of connected events which usually constitutes an occurrence report.

For violent crime, a separate incident is recorded for each victim. If one person assaults 3 people - 3 incidents are recorded.

For non-violent crimes, one incident is counted for every distinct or separate occurrence.

The total criminal code data reflects both violent and property crimes as well as other Criminal Code offences such as damage to property, prostitution, etc.

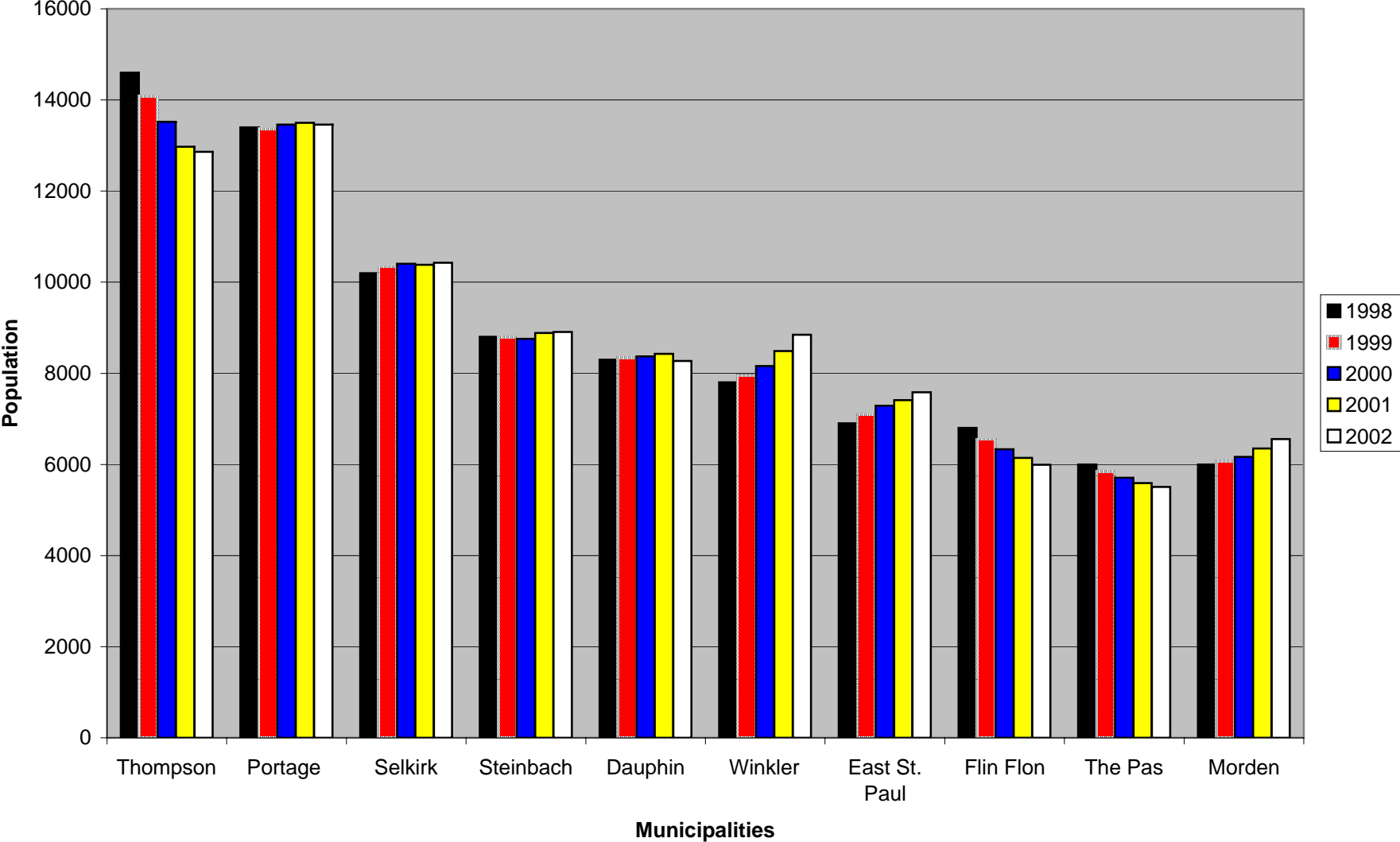

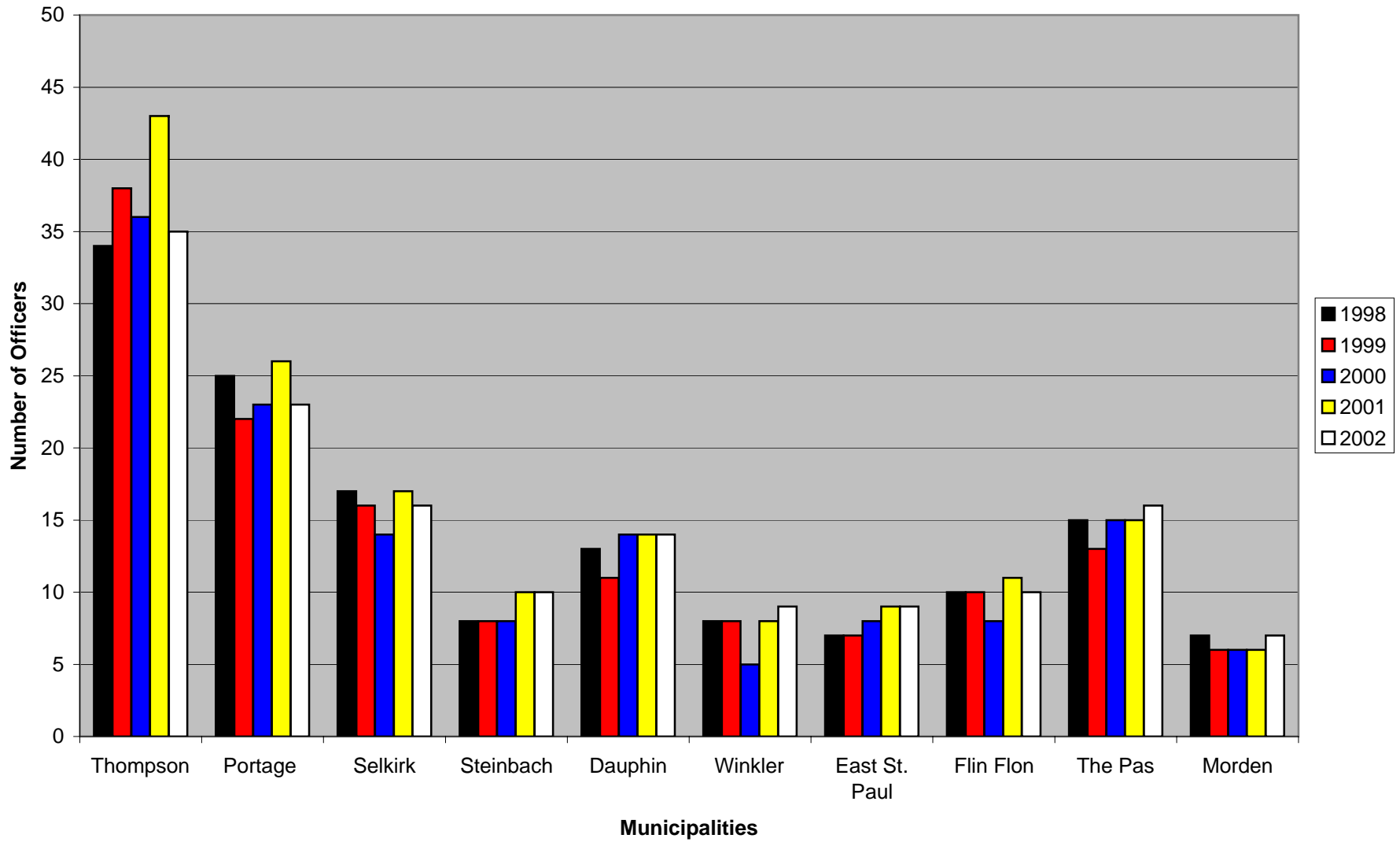

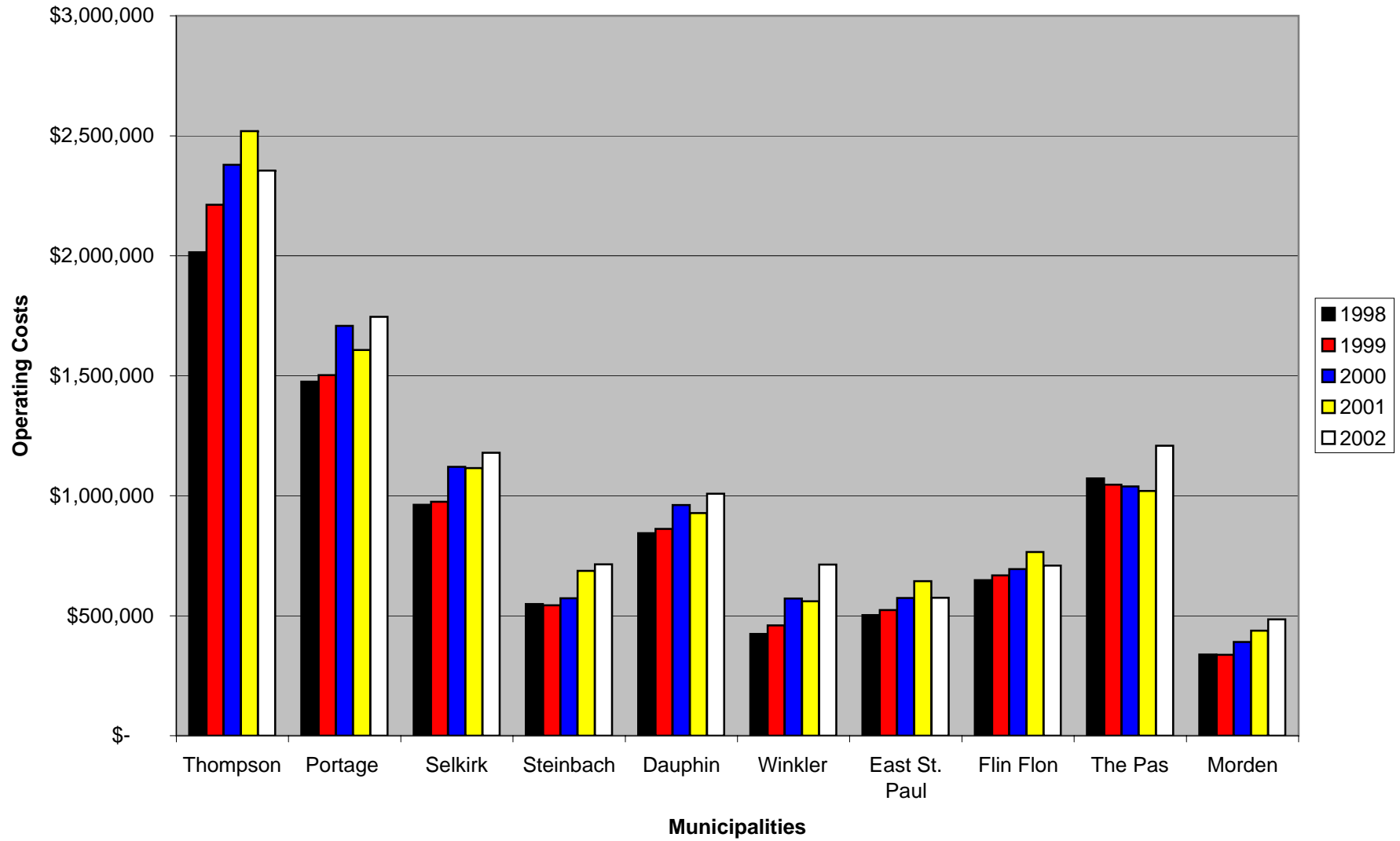
GRAPH 1- Community Populations



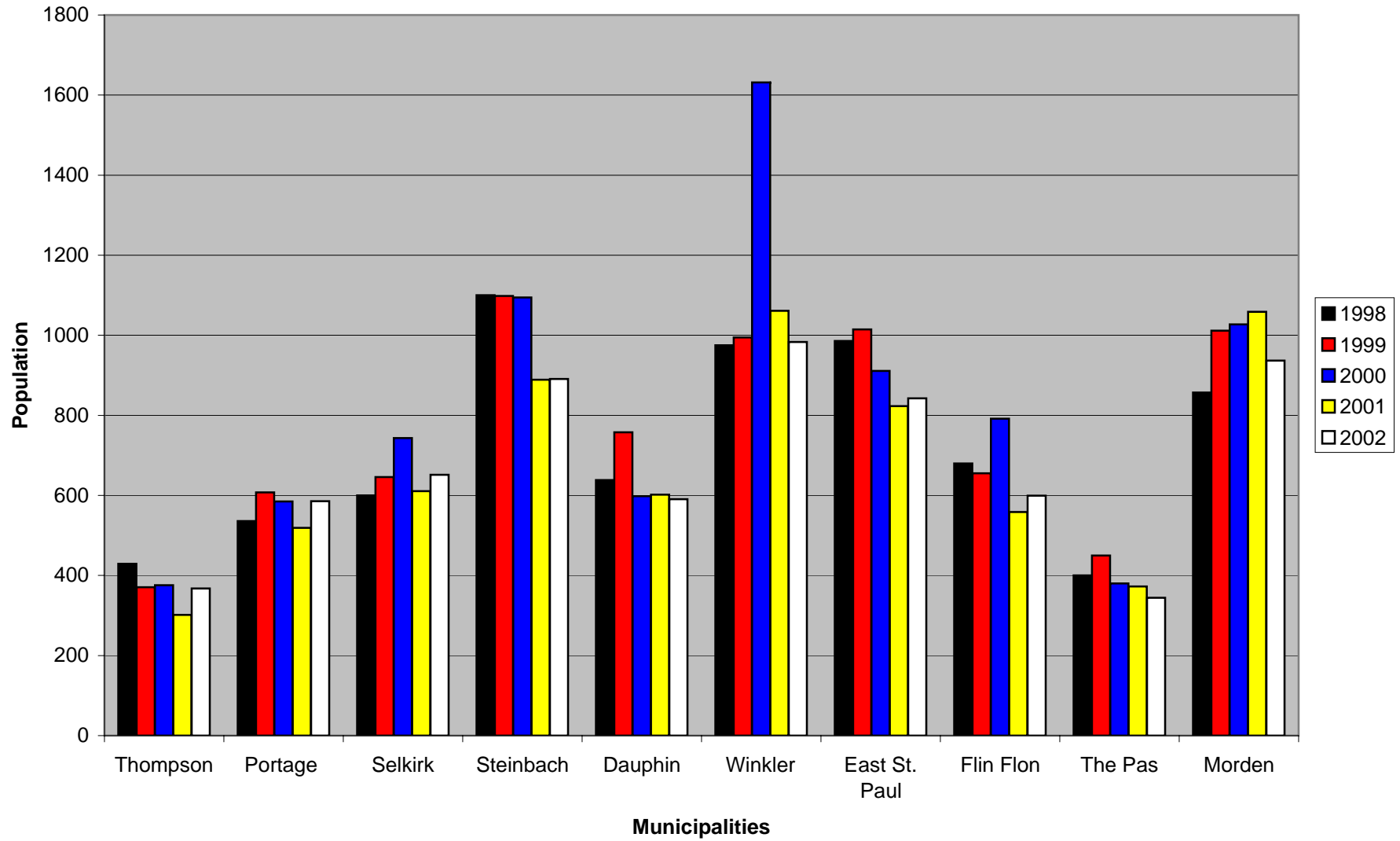
GRAPH 2- Officer Complement



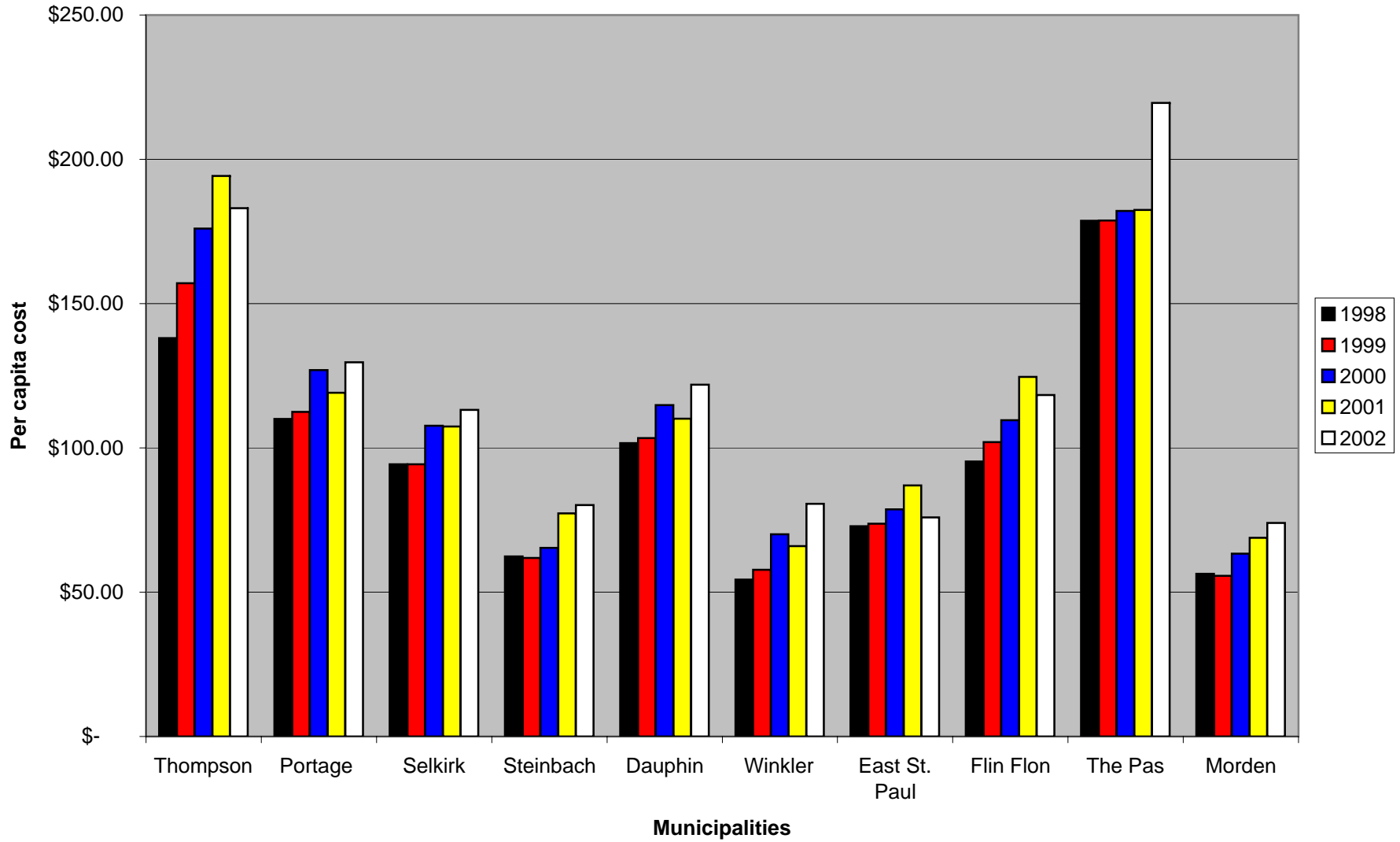
GRAPH 3- Annual Expenditures



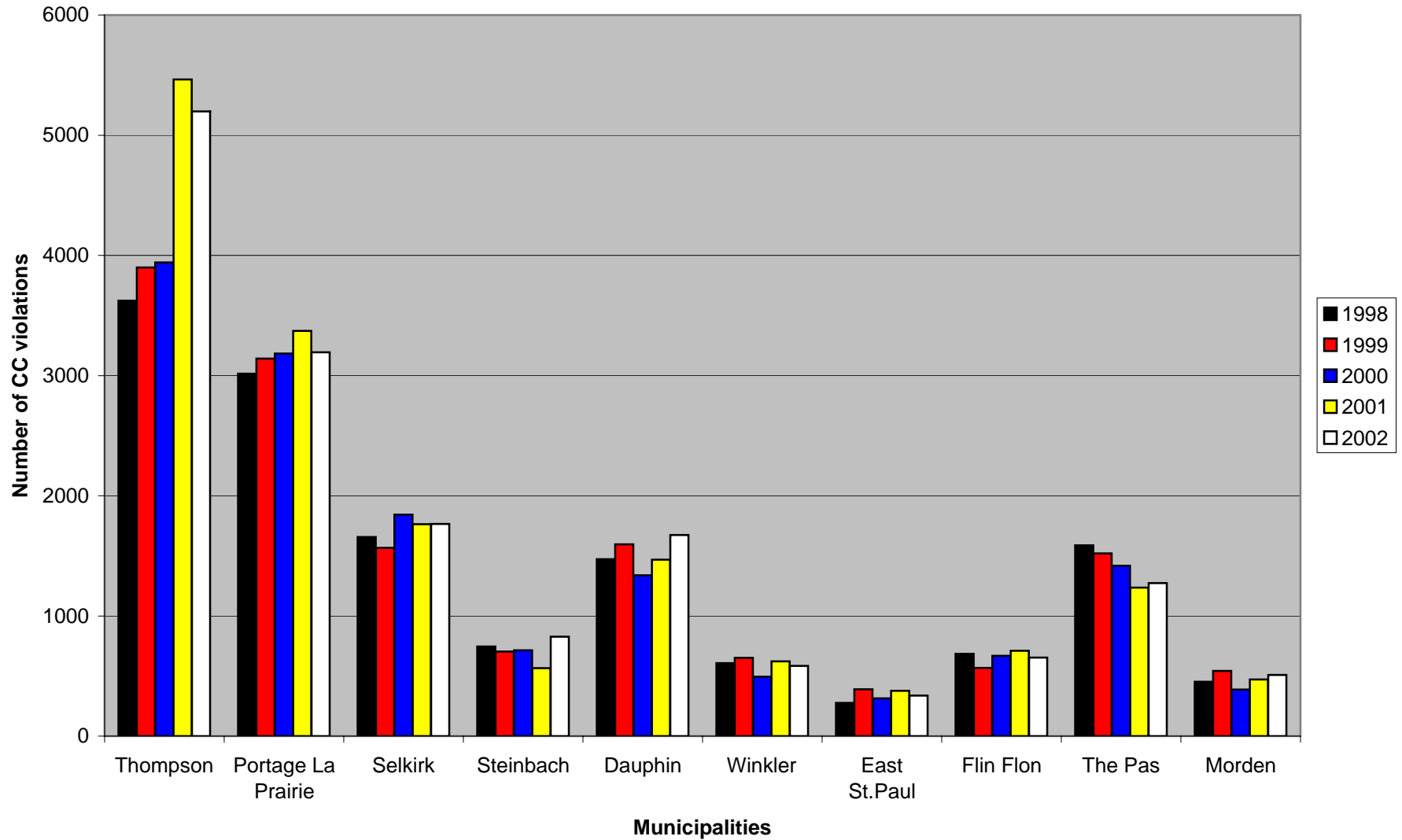
GRAPH 4- Population per police officer



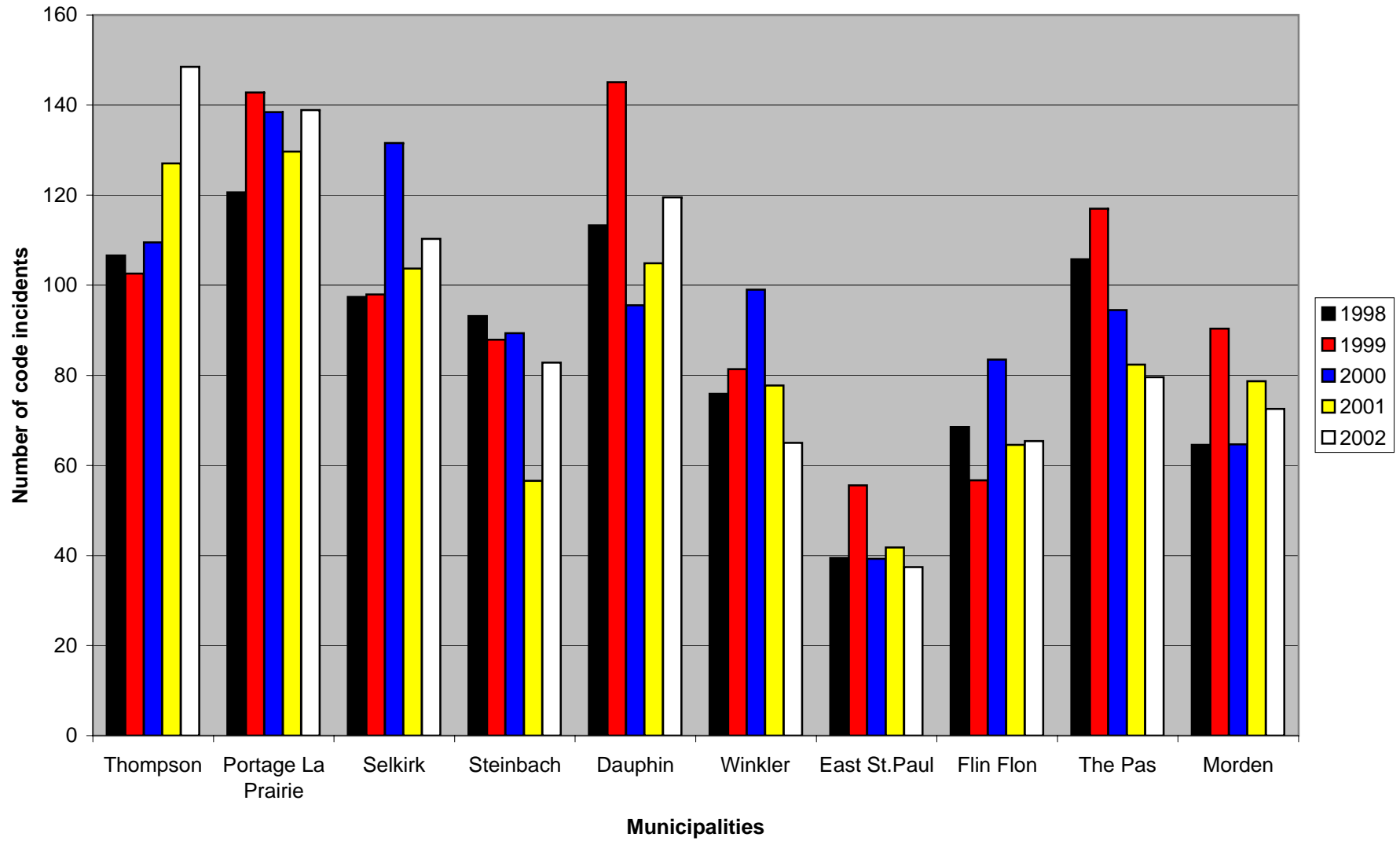
GRAPH 5- Per capita cost of policing
