To All Municipalities:

The AMM has the opportunity to present municipal input into the contract development for the 2012 Provincial Police Services Agreement. This agreement between the Federal and Provincial Governments directly affects municipalities that pay the Province for RCMP services. An effective framework for police services is essential for managing a high quality police service and this is a valuable opportunity to affect Manitoba's agreement.

Therefore, the AMM asks that your council consider any issues with the current contract and submit your feedback to the AMM office no later than June 30, 2009. Although the new contract will not be implemented until 2012, it is necessary to present any municipal concerns at this early stage so they may be considered from the outset.

Specifically, we ask that you consider ways the existing contract impacts service provision and ways to eliminate any barriers to service provision. The purpose of this consultation is less about identifying particular local issues and more about ensuring the broader framework of the agreement facilitates and supports the best possible police services for Manitoba communities.

The AMM will compile the feedback to highlight key themes and areas for improvement, and submit this information to the Provincial Government for consideration as the contract negotiation moves forward.
