

DISPLAYERS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

AMM CONVENTION DISPLAY AREA **NOVEMBER**

1) How many people attend the Convention?

- ❖ Approximately 1000 delegates register. Invited are the Mayors, Reeves, Councillors and Chief Administrative Officers of ALL 198 rural municipalities, towns, villages, local government districts and cities.

2) Where is this event held?

- ❖ This event alternates between Brandon (odd years) and Winnipeg (even years).

3) What time is the display area open and what does it offer?

- ❖ The Convention Display Area is open for 2 days.
- ❖ Display area hours are from Monday 9-4 & Tuesday 9-3:30.
- ❖ Depending on the location there are between 85 and 125 booths available for purchase. Booths are sold out weeks before event so book quickly.
- ❖ Lunch may be purchased in the facility at a pre-determined location, details sent in email and posted online.
- ❖ Correspondence with displayers will be via email so it is important that displayers provide their most current information.
- ❖ Complete all questions on the registration form so that all their needs are met satisfactorily.
- ❖ Website will have current list of registered displayers.
- ❖ Don't forget to sign in upon your arrival to ensure you are informed of specific details for current show and pick up info on next show.

4) How long is the actual Convention?

- ❖ The Convention agenda is 3.5 days starting Monday and ending Thursday at 12:00 p.m.

5) What opportunities do displayers have to be involved?

- ❖ The AMM has many sponsorship opportunities available online and sent in mailings, please review and take advantage of a captive audience.

6) Can anyone attend the Icebreaker evening on Monday night?

2) Where is this event held?

- ❖ This event is held in Brandon at the Keystone Centre each April.

3) How does the MTCML Trade Show work?

- ❖ Open from 11 am to 6pm.
- ❖ Larger of the 2 shows we offer and has over 120 booths including large equipment.
- ❖ Booths are sold out weeks before event, book quickly.
- ❖ Correspondence with MTCML Trade Show Displayers will be via email so it is important that displayers provide the most current information.
- ❖ Website will have current list of registered displayers.
- ❖ Also it is important to complete all questions on the registration form so that all your needs are met satisfactorily.
- ❖ Use the website to find detailed CURRENT information on set up times, meals, take down times etc.
- ❖ There is a sign in at both of our shows where you can pick up the information and applications for the next AMM or MTCML show & all relevant information for the current one so please ensure you don't miss this step.
- ❖ Door prize forms are to be picked up at AMM Booth at registration and handed back in starting at 5:00 pm. Winners are announced and prizes are picked up at your booth during Wine & Cheese.
