2016 Census data released

The first 2016 Census data release - population and dwelling counts - was released on February 8, 2017. According to 2016 Census data, Manitoba's population has grown to 1,278,265, representing a 5.8% increase.

MPI rate increase

Manitoba Public Insurance has confirmed a rate increase for basic and complex firefighting payments. These rates increase on March 1 annually, based on the prior year's C.P.I. plus 1%.

Effective March 1, 2017, the basic call rate will increase from \$788 to \$806, and the complex call rate will increase from \$1,051 to \$1,075. These increases are based on the 2016 Manitoba C.P.I. rate of 1.3% (resulting in a 2.3% increase.)
