# National Trade Corridors Fund (NTCF)

On July 4, Transport Minister Marc Garneau announced the details for the federal government's <u>National Trade Corridors</u> <u>Fund (NTCF)</u> and launched the application period for funding requests. The fund will provide \$2 billion over 11 years to projects that reduce bottlenecks at major transportation hubs and modernize Canada's transportation network, including municipal priorities such as roads, bridges and grade separations.


