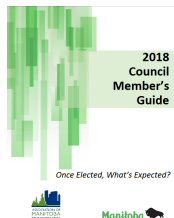
2018 Municipal Elections website - Election Results

The AMM congratulates all municipal elected officials and commends all candidates for participating in the 2018 Manitoba Municipal Elections. In total, 48% of officials are newly elected while 30% of elected officials were acclaimed.

Preliminary statistics indicated an overall increase in women elected officials across the province. 20% -174 out of 879 - of all elected officials are women, which represents a 3% overall increase from 2014. 21 women were also elected Head of Council, Mayor or Reeve; 15 were elected in 2014.

Full unofficial municipal election results can be found on [MBvotes.ca](#) which compiles election information from all of Manitoba's 137 incorporated municipalities.

"Today, Statistics Canada published the first results of [Canada's Core Public Infrastructure Survey](#)

Sponsored by Infrastructure Canada and conducted with Statistics Canada's world-class expertise in data management, the survey will provide trusted and reliable data to support governments and policy makers in monitoring the condition of Canada's core public infrastructure, improving their management and lifespan, and developing future infrastructure projects.

Building on the first release, statistical information on national infrastructure assets will be released throughout the fall of 2018 and will provide baselines for comparing assets over time. The data will examine the inventory, condition, performance and asset management strategy of nine core public infrastructure assets: roads; bridges and tunnels; potable water; waste water; storm water; public transit; solid waste; culture, recreation and sports facilities; and public social and affordable housing.

Statistics Canada is working with Infrastructure Canada to explore the possibility of producing this survey on a recurring basis to develop a broader overview of Canada's public infrastructures over time."
