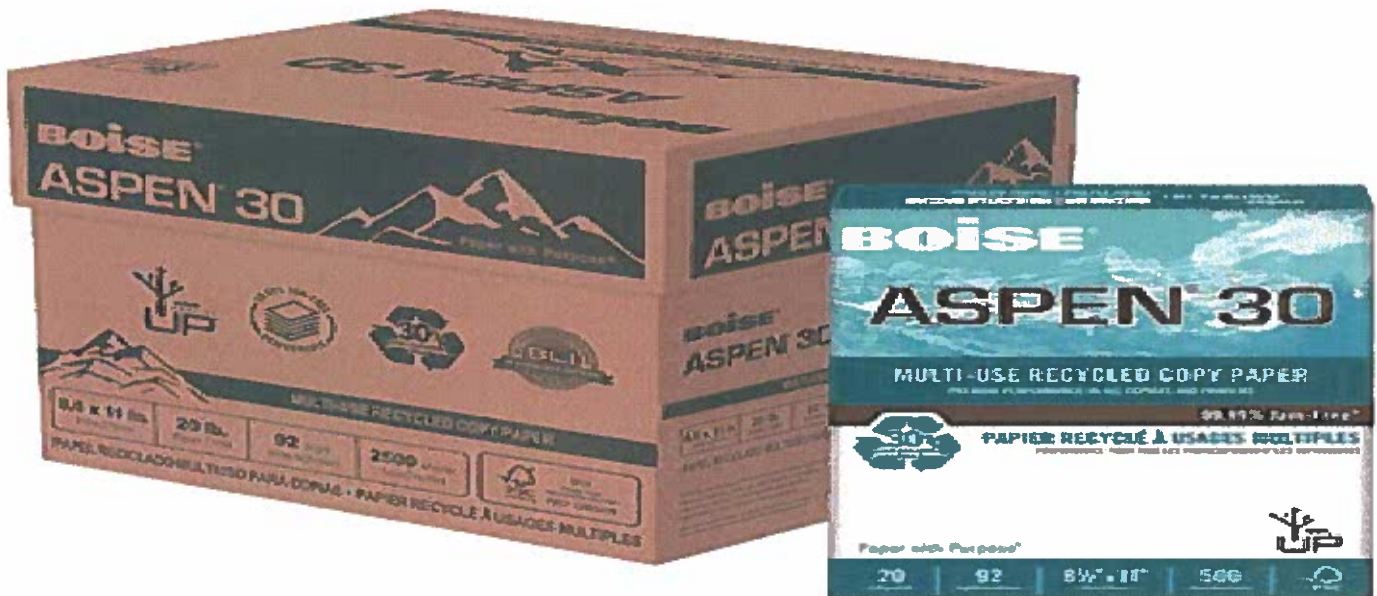

GET TO KNOW – RECYCLED PAPER

While sustainable forest management helps protect our forests, recycled paper helps protect our planet. Paper products are the most widely recycled materials in the world, and – once recovered, graded, and cleaned – give new life to what was once considered waste.



Recycling one ton of paper diverts more than 3.3 cubic yards of waste from landfills.¹



Over 60% of paper products are recovered and recycled (compared to 28% for glass, 20% for aluminum, and 9% for plastics).²



33% of the material used to make paper in the United States comes from recycled paper; 33% comes from wood chips/scrap from sawmills.³

Paper fibers can be recycled five to seven times before they are too short to bond into new paper. New fibers must be added to replace those that wash out during the recycling process.

You play a vital role in ensuring a consistent supply of high-quality recycled office papers. PLEASE recycle your office paper, and segregate it from other recycled waste streams to minimize contamination and ensure the maximum quality of recovered fibers.
