Apply for funding under the Climate Change and Adaptation to Extreme Weather Infrastructure component of the Rail Safety Improvement Program (RSIP)





Transports Canada Canada

Minister of Transport, the Honourable Omar Alghabra, announced the launch of the first call for proposals for the Climate Change and Adaptation to Extreme Weather Infrastructure initiative under Transport Canada's Rail Safety Improvement Program.

The Climate Change and Adaptation to Extreme Weather Infrastructure initiative will provide up to \$10.5 million in funding this year. This initiative specifically targets rail infrastructure projects meant to increase resilience to extreme weather events and advance measures to address

climate change measures. It will also support rehabilitation projects that repair damage from significant weather events.

Transport Canada will be accepting applications for the <u>Climate Change and Adaptation to</u> <u>Extreme Weather Infrastructure initiative</u> through an open, competitive call for proposals from now until **January 6, 2023**

The Green and Inclusive Community Buildings (GICB) Program is launching its second scheduled intake and is now accepting applications through the following intake streams:

Scheduled

Eligible applicants with large projects to retrofit existing community buildings or projects to build new community buildings with total eligible costs ranging from \$3 million to \$25 million can apply now **until February 28, 2023, 15:00 ET.**

Continuous

The <u>GICB</u> Program continues to accept applications from eligible applicants for small and medium sized projects to retrofit existing community buildings ranging in total eligible cost from \$100,000 to \$3 million **until February 28, 2023, 15:00 ET**.

On December 5, the Honourable Dominic LeBlanc, Minister of Intergovernmental Affairs, Infrastructure and Communities, announced the launch of a second application intake for the **Green and Inclusive Community Buildings** program.

Under the <u>Green and Inclusive Community Buildings</u> program, the Government of Canada is investing in green and accessible retrofits, repairs, and upgrades to improve existing community buildings, as well as the construction of new publicly accessible community buildings.


