By-election for AMM Central District Director



A special meeting to elect the Central District Director will be held at the AMM Annual Convention on November 25, 2015 immediately following adjournment. We request all [Central District](#) members attend.

- *Candidates for the positions of Director will be nominated from the floor.*
- *The by-election of the District Director shall take place at the Annual Convention by way of a vote of all attending delegates from the Central District. Those entitled to vote shall be all elected officials and Chief Administrative Officers of any member municipality. Each elected official and Chief Administrative Officer shall have the right to exercise one vote.*
- *The Director elected at the special meeting shall serve for the remaining term of the vacant directorship for which he or she has been elected, which will be until June 2017. There shall be no limit on the number of years that a Director can hold office.*

Communities Recognized for Outstanding Emergency Preparedness Programs

[Prairie View Municipality](#) and the [City of Brandon](#) are the recipients of the first Manitoba Community Emergency Preparedness Awards recognizing communities with programs meeting or exceeding standards. The awards were presented by the Province of Manitoba and the Association of Manitoba Municipalities during the Manitoba Disaster Management Conference in Winnipeg earlier this month.

The award will be presented annually to two recipients; one community or municipality over 2,500 residents and one community or municipality with fewer than 2,500 residents. The award includes public recognition by the Manitoba government, a framed certificate and road signs stating, 'We are a Prepared Community', to be placed at the municipality's discretion.

The Emergency Measures Act requires communities to have emergency preparedness programs. This award recognizes four levels of achievement in community preparedness, modeled on Canadian and international best practices and standards.
