

The Health Products Stewardship Association (HPSA) officially launched the Manitoba Sharps Collection Program on January 15, 2021 shortly after the Ministry of Conservation and Climate's approval. The program fulfills a regulation that calls for a province-wide, convenient collection network for used medical sharps at no cost to the public. Costs for the Manitoba Sharps Collection Program (MSCP) are covered by medical sharps manufacturers. HPSA manages the Sharps Collection Program on behalf of its members. *Read More*
