Municipal Act to be Reviewed

The Manitoba government will be reviewing the Municipal Act to identify opportunities to strengthen protections for municipal officials, Municipal Relations Minister Jeff Wharton announced on April 23 at the Manitoba Municipal Administrators Association (MMAA) Conference and Annual General Meeting.

"The province will review The Municipal Act and other relevant legislation to identify opportunities to strengthen municipalities' ability to enforce violations of their codes of conduct," said Minister Wharton. "Any potential amendments would require careful consideration and would be developed in consultation with municipalities and other stakeholders."

The province will be consulting with both the AMM and the MMAA through a series of roundtable discussions across the province in June and September where input will be gathered on potential legislative changes.

"Everyone deserves a safe and respectful work environment including municipal elected officials," said Chris Goertzen, president, Association of Manitoba Municipalities. "We look forward to working with Minister Wharton to determine ways to strengthen not only the legislation around harassment and bullying in municipal workplaces, but our ability to enforce the rules."
