

The new regulations by the Canada Free Trade Agreement (CFTA) and the Northwest Partnership Trade Agreement (NWPTA) require any buying group, such as the Trading Company, to complete Request for Proposals (RFP) for any supplier

Public Safety Communications Service Project Update

As a reminder, transition from FleetNet to PSCS will occur between April 2020 and May 2021. Following the transition period, Fleetnet radios that have not been transitioned to PSCS will no longer have service. The fines are tied to population, and while the Agreement on Internal Trade's maximum penalty was \$5 million, the new maximum fine is \$10 million.'
