Manitoba Families Minister Rochelle Squires, Minister responsible for Accessibility, announced the Manitoba Accessibility Fund (MAF) 2022/23, with \$750,000 to be awarded in grants.

Low Carbon Economy Challenge - Champions Stream

The <u>Low Carbon Economy Challenge</u> is part of the <u>Low Carbon Economy Fund (LCEF)</u>. It leverages Canadian ingenuity to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and generate clean growth in support of Canada's clean growth and climate action plans by providing approximately \$500 million to a wide range of recipients.

The Challenge is divided into two streams: the **Champions stream** and the **Partnerships** stream.

The Champions stream is currently accepting Expression of Interest submissions until March 25, 2022 at 08:00 pm (EDT).

Key date

- March 25, 2022: Deadline for Expressions of Interest
- May 2022: Invitation to submit Formal Proposal (or notification of ineligibility)
- Fall 2022: Final funding decisions
- Project completion: No later than March 2025
