The Association of Manitoba Municipalities (AMM) has kicked-off its annual round of municipal visits by meeting this week with several municipalities in the Western District.

"Meeting one-on-one with individual Councils allows us to gain invaluable local insights to advance municipal priorities as well as learn about challenges and opportunities facing local communities. This is especially important as the provincial government settles into its new mandate and prepares Budget 2024," noted AMM President Kam Blight.

Joining Blight will be Vice-President Kathy Valentino, Western District Directors Rhonda Coupland and Scott Phillips, and Executive Director Denys Volkov.

The AMM delegation will be meeting with Town Of Carberry, Cartwright-Roblin Municipality, Prairie Lakes Municipality, Municipality of Oakland-Wawanesa, City of Brandon - Local Government, and RM of Elton.

Please note that Education and Awareness projects will be prioritized over Research and Technology projects for this Call for Proposals.

RSIP provides federal funding to help improve rail safety, contribute to increasing safety at grade crossings and along rail lines, address climate change resilience, and increase public confidence in Canada's rail transportation system.

This new component of the program supports activities and initiatives aimed at improving rail safety to reduce injuries and fatalities, as well as reducing grade crossing collisions and trespassing incidents on railway property.


