Community Economic Development Training Opportunities



The MB Community Edge Municipal Capacity Building Project is an initiative that will deliver

CED capacity building training to over 300 municipal officials and community leaders across all rural and northern Manitoba. The project will see Community Edge, Manitoba's CED Certification Program, offered in ten regional centres across the province. Sessions will be offered with two modules/day in each region.

The four modules are valued at \$900 but are being offered at an amazing rate of **\$50 per day (\$25/module)** thanks to funding made available through the Prairies Rural Opportunities Fund 2.0. The project is being supported by Manitoba Community Futures Offices.

The dates for the next five sessions are noted <u>HERE</u>. Three northern Manitoba sessions will be announced closer to the spring. Space is limited so encourage interested participants to sign-up ASAP to ensure a seat (full day registration required) . This is an excellent opportunity to learn CED essentials and share experiences with other colleagues right here in the region.

Critical Minerals Infrastructure Fund

The Critical Minerals Infrastructure Fund (CMIF) will provide up to \$1.5 billion in federal funding over 7 years for clean energy and transportation infrastructure projects necessary to enable the sustainable development and expansion of critical minerals in Canada.

There will be calls for proposals launched over the course of this 7-year program. The first call for proposals is open now, with up to \$300 million in contribution funding available.
