Businesses, community organizations and other eligible recipients are invited to apply for funding through the 2017 Enabling Accessibility Fund (EAF) Call for Proposals. This call for proposals includes **Workplace Accessibility** and **Community Accessibility** funding streams.

Community organizations can receive project funding of up to \$50,000. Not-for-profit organizations, for-profit organizations, small municipalities (population under 125,000), Indigenous organizations and territorial governments are eligible to apply by **Wednesday, July 26, 2017**

Spread the Word - Not the Mussels

The Riding Mountain UNESCO World Biosphere Reserve (RMBR) is concerned about the socioeconomic and environmental impacts of the spread of Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS), especially Zebra Mussels, into our AIS-free lakes and watersheds in Manitoba.

As AIS spread is largely due to the introduction of AIS into new waters by contaminated boats and water-related equipment, our ultimate defense is a widespread awareness of AIS.

The RMBR has developed an 'Online information kit' that includes key links to Manitoba AIS information sources and pertinent materials posted by other jurisdictions, which are also striving to stop the spread. We are focusing on the Zebra Mussel, as it is the predominant threat and its control measures are applicable to many other invasive species.
