2018 Provincial Budget

AMM President Chris Goertzen attended the reading of the 2018 provincial budget at the Manitoba Legislature on March 12. The AMM was pleased to see an approximate \$6.5M increase for municipal capital grants outside the City of Winnipeg, more funding for the Community Places Program, and \$5M over three years to create the Manitoba Heritage Trust Program.

However, freezing municipal operating and public safety funding at 2016 levels does not recognize inflationary increases and puts greater financial and administrative pressures on municipalities. "The reality is, 2016 dollars for 2018 problems will be a challenge," President Goertzen said.
