Cities Adapt with Flood-Resilient Infrastructure Webinar

Across Canada, different types of public infrastructure are impacted by a wide range of climate

hazards. Each year, municipal buildings, transportation systems, water supply, wastewater treatment and many other types of public infrastructure are affected by severe weather events in communities across the country.

As Canadian municipalities continue to be threatened and impacted by these events, most communities are rethinking the way they design and manage municipal infrastructure to ensure their long-term durability and performance under current and future climate conditions.

The recently published report: Cities Adapt with Climate Resilient Infrastructure: Celebrating Local Leadership showcases 20 case studies of communities that implemented strong actions to increase the resilience of their public infrastructure. This presentation will focus specifically on flood resilient infrastructure.


