MPI Firefighting Reimbursement Form / Annual Rate Increase

Since 2009, the rates for basic and complex firefighting payments made by Manitoba Public Insurance (MPI) have increased each year on March 1. The increase is based on the prior year's C.P.I. plus 1%.

The basic call rate has now increased from \$806 to \$827, and the complex call rate has increased from \$1075 to \$1103 based on the 2017 Manitoba CPI rate of 1.6% (resulting in a 2.6% increase). The new rates are in effect for losses occurring on March 1, 2018 and later.

In addition, in consultation with the AMM, MPI has enhanced its firefighting cost reimbursement form to streamline the invoicing process, increase response times, create consistency between billing amounts and payment amounts as well as reduce administration time.
