Manitoba Municipalities Unveil Provincial Election Priorities



May 5, 2023 - The Association of Manitoba Municipalities (AMM) unveiled its pre-election campaign today under the slogan "<u>Let's Grow Manitoba Together</u>," identifying key policy priorities for Manitoba's 137 municipalities in advance of the 2023 provincial election.
