Manitoba Government Invests Additional \$15 Million for Municipalities to Support Road Repairs

Manitoba Government Launches \$1.5 Million Conservation and Climate Fund

The Manitoba government is now accepting applications for the Conservation and Climate Fund and has increased the size of the fund to \$1.5 million.

Grants will be available for selected projects that support current priorities and align with at least one of three categories: clean technology, water, nature and resilient landscapes.

Eligible applicants include incorporated non-profit organizations, academic and educational institutions, municipalities, businesses, northern and Indigenous communities.

The application intake is now live and will close on **June 17**.

Province Announces Third Intake for Quarry Rehabilitation Program

The Manitoba government is opening a third intake for the Quarry Rehabilitation on Private and Municipal Land Program.

“Our government is committed to supporting the rehabilitation of depleted pits and quarries on private and municipal lands. Up to \$2.8 million, which is the projected balance of the Quarry Rehabilitation Reserve Account, will be available for the 2022-23 program. - Natural Resources and Northern Development Minister Scott Fielding.

Applications will be open until **June 15** and **successful grant recipients** will be notified in **mid-July**. **Approved projects** must be completed by **Jan. 31, 2023**.

RECYCLE EVERYWHERE



At Recycle Everywhere, we continue to support Manitoba municipalities by providing beverage container recycling infrastructure and resources. Our single-family dwelling (SFD) bin makes recycling in homes more convenient. This extra 7-gallon bin can be used in home offices, kitchens or wherever people typically consume beverages. The small size also makes it perfect for transporting materials to a recycling consolidation bin or depot. Our bin is available for free to all SFD homes in Manitoba on a community basis.

Many municipalities have already taken advantage of this free initiative including: Winnipeg, Steinbach, Niverville, Beausejour, Swan River, Neepawa, Ste. Anne and the RMs of East St. Paul, West St. Paul, Killarney, Springfield and Brenda-Waskada. Many of these municipalities have agreed to set up

distribution sites for residents to come and pick up their bins, while others have distributed these bins door-to-door. Thank you all for your support in helping us make at-home recycling easier for Manitobans.

"Our residents are very pleased as it enables them to take smaller quantities to their bins as opposed to lugging a larger bag or container." – Town of Neepawa

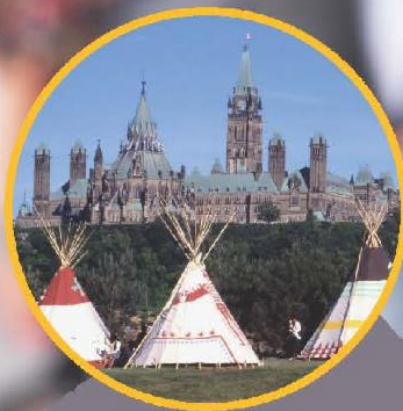
