Province Streamlines Community Development Programs

The Manitoba government has launched a new <u>Building Sustainable</u> <u>Communities Program</u> that will streamline and modernize grant support to non-profit organizations, Municipal Relations Minister Jeff Wharton announced April 4, 2019.

"Our government recognizes the importance of community development initiatives and supporting non-profit organizations," said Wharton. "This new program will support a broader range of community-led projects and deliver on our mandate to renew community development programs to best serve the needs of Manitobans."

"The Association of Manitoba Municipalities is pleased to partner with the province in assessing the applications and making recommendations on the Building Sustainable Communities Program," said Ralph Groening, president, AMM. "These projects are essential in promoting economic development and sustainability throughout our province."

2019 June District Meetings

AMM Members are invited to attend the Association of Manitoba Municipalities,

2019 June District Meetings.

This series of meetings visits each of the seven AMM districts and provides the opportunity for the AMM members to discuss a number of important municipal issues and bring forward resolutions for the 2019 Annual Convention.

AMM Board of Director Elections Process

Elections for each AMM Board of Directors will take place in all 7 Districts.

- Each District is entitled to 2 Directors per District and you must be an elected official to be nominated and sit on the AMM Board.
- Voting will be at the June district meeting in your area and all elected officials and CAOs within the District are entitled to vote at the District meeting for Directors.
- Nominations are made at the meeting and to nominate a candidate, you must be an elected official or CAO.

Term of office for Directors will be from June 2019 to June 2021.

Candidates nominated will have up to 4 minutes to address the delegates at the June District meeting and the candidates that receive the 2 highest votes will be declared elected.

The Workplace Emergency Response Information Toolkit

The Province has introduced the second accessibility standard under the AMA, which is initially focused on employee safety and inclusion.

Safety comes first. To ensure employee safety, by May 1, 2020, all Manitoba employers with one or more employees, including your organization, must have:

- plans to provide individualized emergency response information to keep employees with disabilities safe; and,
- permission from all employees who require assistance during an emergency to share that information with other individuals in the organization who have agreed to provide support.

<u>The Workplace Emergency Response Information Toolkit</u> includes more information and a sample template to get you started.

Specialty Programs offered by the Trading

The Manitoba Emergency Services College is offering one of the three scheduled workshops for Elected Officials and CAO's: April 25, May 14, or June 11.

The Fire Protection Workshop is an introductory one-day course (5 hours) designed to provide Elected Officials, Chief Administrative Officers and other senior RM personnel with a more comprehensive understanding about the scope, roles and needs facing their local fire service.

- The seminar portion of the program will provide information about legislation, requirements on structure and operations, along with the administration and organization of emergency services. The format will be presentations and discussion.
- The practical portion of the program will involve showing and using equipment, operating apparatus, and simulated firefighting scenarios.

FleetNet Replacement Project

Manitoba has entered into a publicly tendered agreement with Bell Mobility Inc. (Bell) for a new Public Safety Communications Service (PSCS). The PSCS will provide a modern mobile radio service for public safety and public service organizations in Manitoba, and will replace the Very High Frequency radio network used by Manitoba Sustainable Development.

Over 99% of Manitobans live in the areas that will be covered by the PSCS. Engineered to be highly reliable, the PSCS is based on modern communications standards and will be built with modern infrastructure and equipment. Implementation of the PSCS infrastructure, and transition of public safety and public service users to the new service, will take up to three years (i.e., from fiscal year 2018/19 to 2020/2021). It is anticipated that municipalities will start transitioning to the PSCS beginning in 2020.
