

Public Review on Construction Code Changes Now OPEN!

The Canadian Board for Harmonized Construction Codes (CBHCC) has posted a public review of proposed changes for inclusion in the 2025 editions of the national model construction codes. As Manitoba is limited in its ability to amend the national codes due to commitments under the Canadian Free Trade Agreement, affected code users are encouraged to participate in code development at the national level.

The proposed changes included in this public review address various topics in the National Building Code of Canada, the National Plumbing Code of Canada, the National Fire Code of Canada, and the National Energy Code of Canada for Buildings. Code users and interested parties are invited to visit the <u>CBHCC's website</u>, examine the proposed changes, and provide feedback.

The public review runs until December 18, 2023. The review period is an opportunity for all Canadians to participate in the code development process.

After the review period closes, members of the relevant code development committees will review the comments received and make recommendations on the proposed changes. If approved, the code changes will be included in the 2025 editions of the National Model Codes.
