Latest News

New Climate and Green Plan Discussion Document

On October 27 Manitoba Sustainable Development released <u>A Made in Manitoba Climate and Green Plan</u> discussion paper. President Goertzen attended the announcement by Premier Brian Pallister and Sustainable Development Minister Rochelle Squires.

Initial takeaways:

- The provincial government intends to implement a carbon price of \$25 per tonne starting next year.
- This translates into a 5-cent increase per litre of fuel.
- While this amount is half of the federal government's \$50 per tonne target by 2022, it will still result in added costs to municipal operations.
- The complementary output-based pricing scheme for large emitters will not apply to municipal landfills.
- The carbon pricing plan is expected to generate approximately \$260M in revenue per year, however how the funds will be allocated has yet to be determined.
- The government will create an 'Expert Advisory Commission' that will make recommendations how the revenue could be allocated; the AMM has requested to participate in this Commission.

The Province has initiated an <u>online survey</u> to collect feedback on the Plan. The deadline to complete the online survey is **November 30, 2017.** It also invites participation in <u>discussion topics.</u>



Bill 24 - The Red Tape Reduction and Government Efficiency Act



AMM Vice-President Ralph Groening made a presentation to the Standing Committee on Social and Economic Development on Bill 24 - The Red Tape Reduction and Government Efficiency Act on October 23.

Approximately 90 per cent of Manitoba municipalities have indicated to the AMM that they encounter provincial red tape on a regular basis resulting in added financial or staff resources and delays when dealing with provincial Acts, regulations, license

requirements, and permit applications.

Webinar: Information Session on the Upcoming New Home Warranty Legislation for Permit Issuers

The Consumer Protection Office invites permit issuers to participate in an interactive webinar on Manitoba's new home warranty legislation.



The New Home Warranty Act comes into effect on January 1, 2018.

When it is in force, permit issuers will be required to check that home builders are registered with the Consumer Protection Office (CPO) and have secured warranty backing for each new home they want to build.

The CPO is offering a series of free regional webinars to provide an overview of the new legislation, builder requirements, permit issuer responsibilities and the new online systems that are being developed. Webinars will take place between **November 7 and 21**.
