









HOW MUCH IS YOUR MUNICIPALITY SHORT?





WHAT FURTHER ACTIONS SHOULD THE PROVINCIAL OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TAKE TO HELP WITH YOUR RECOVERY?

Upgrade cell & internet service, better options for infrastructure

Continue funding & allow municipalities to decide how funds are used

Infrastructure funding, approve/release ICIP projects, nonrestrictive grants

Keep lines of communication open, keep municipalities well informed and listen to municipal concerns.



WHAT FURTHER ACTIONS SHOULD THE PROVINCIAL OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TAKE TO HELP WITH YOUR RECOVERY?

Increase healthcare services/staff, proper vaccination role out

Provide prompt response on grant applications. Flow funding quicker. Increase funding to offset operating costs

Per capita funding doesnt articulate actual revenue short falls. Future funding should look at revenue short falls experienced due to pandemic.

Partner with municipalities & support capital works projects. Include municipalities in wage subsidies.
