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### **Property & Casualty Program Structure**

- Unique AMM-Member owned "Protected Self- Insurance" Program, with annual AMM-held loss pool that pays 1<sup>st</sup> portion of claims
- Completely different from other types of insurance Ownership and Control
- Excess insurance provided by commercial insurers for complete protection
- Unused loss pool funds belong to Municipalities











#### Property & Casualty Program Structure cont'd

- "Guaranteed new replacement cost" protection for buildings, also for mobile machinery and equipment up to 10 years old
- Includes increased costs due to building code / by-law requirements
- \$35,000,000 liability protection
- Crime, boiler and accident coverage











## April 1, 2014 Property/Casualty Renewal

- WFGIS periodically tenders the excess insurance coverage to 20-25 insurers to ensure that we get the best rates available
- 11 insurers share the program risks
- Program has been set up to provide long term stability
- Municipalities maintain ownership and control of their insurance program

### Financial Stability – Loss Pool Refund

- Estimated total value of insured property has increased from \$3.5 Billion to \$4.3 Billion over the last 5 years
- Program surplus \$2,458,354 as at October 31, 2014
- 5 months claims left to go in current year; current year claims trend is towards \$5,500,000-\$6,000,000











#### Financial Stability - Loss Pool Refund cont'd

- In calculating annually the amount (if any) to be refunded, \$2,000,000 is always retained for "Incurred-But-Not-Reported" claims (owned by municipalities)
- \$7,792,100 in Loss Pool Premium has been returned to Municipalities over the past 10 years











## **Risk Management**

- WFGIS continues to conduct inspections of municipal buildings and facilities to assess hazards and make recommendations to reduce claims
- We regularly assess building construction details to verify valuations
- We have completed 200 inspections and reviews of municipal facilities in the past year











#### Risk Management cont'd

- We continue to conduct Risk Management seminars at AMM MOS sessions and Municipal Group Conferences and present playground safety courses
- We work with the AMM to develop resources and contacts that Manitoba Municipalities can draw on to assist with the development of their Safety and Health Plans and Staff Training Programs
- We are regularly consulted by Municipalities on Liability and Risk Management issues











#### **Health and Dental**

- Self-insured since Jan/05, with claim payment services by Manitoba Blue Cross
- Accumulated surplus owned by municipalities \$1,029,600 as at September 30, 2014
- Average annual premium rate increase 3.5% since self-insured, much lower than other group benefit plans; anticipate 4% increase for January 2015











#### Health and Dental cont'd

- 148 municipalities participate, plus 243 others like conservation, recreation, planning, and weed districts, and retirees
- 1,817 employees/Councillors insured, 4,543 including dependents
- Total premiums now \$4,494,000 annual
