### **Property & Casualty Program Structure**

- "Protected self-insurance", with annual AMM-held loss pool that pays 1<sup>st</sup> portion of claims
- Excess insurance provided by commercial insurers for complete protection
- Un-used loss pool funds belong to municipalities





- "Guaranteed replacement cost" protection for buildings, also for mobile machinery and equipment up to 10 years old
- \$35,000,000 liability protection
- Crime, boiler and accident coverage





### **April 1, 2013 Property/Casualty Renewal**

- Claims in 12-13 policy year were \$4,930,407 (as of May 31, 2013)
- Total insured values for 2013 Renewal -\$3.99 Billion up from \$3.76 Billion in 2012
- 6 insurers share the program property risks on renewal





- 4.0% increase in total cost to municipalities \$11,273,000 as at April 2012 up to \$11,724,000 on renewal April 1, 2013
- Self-Insurance loss pool \$6,100,000
- Excess insurance cost \$5,624,000, up from \$5,173,000

### **April 1, 2013 Property/Casualty Renewal**

- The program surplus has grown from \$306,000
   March 31, 2008 to \$4,405,151 May 31, 2013,
   surplus is owned by municipalities; program is stable
- \$2,000,000 is retained for "incurred-but-notreported" claims
- \$2,405,151 (21.3% of 2012-13 premiums) is now refundable.
- \$7,792,090 has been returned since 2004





### Risk Management

- Inspect larger municipal buildings and recreational facilities
- Assist Municipalities with liability issues
- Loss Prevention bulletins, Municipal Leader articles and MOS seminars
- Playground safety guide and training courses for municipal inspectors





### **Risk Management**

- Worked with AMM to arrange a supplier (Safety Services Manitoba) to assist municipalities in developing their Safety and Health programs
- Worked with AMM to determine the how COR Certification applies to Municipalities.





### **Health and Dental**

- Self-insured since Jan/05, with claim payment services by Manitoba Blue Cross
- Accumulated surplus owned by municipalities \$777,500 as at April 30, 2013
- Average annual premium increase 2.7% in last 5 years, much lower than other group benefit plans





- 148 municipalities participate, plus 202 others like conservation districts, recreation, planning districts, weed districts, and retirees
- 1,807 employees/Councillors insured,
   4,603 including dependents
- Total premiums now \$4,547,500 annual.
